



# 12 Steps to a Professional Air Duct Cleaning Job!

### Step 1. Trained Technicians

### Step 2. Powerful Vacuum

Our twin-engine vacuum and dust collection system is among the most powerful units available in the air duct cleaning industry.



### Step 3. Complete Set-Up

Work will not begin until your floors are protected against dirt or scratching. Protective shoe covers are worn at all time.



### Step 4. Video Inspection (optional)

If needed our specialized video cameras can be used during the process if there is a question about dead rodents or debris.



### Step 5. Negative Air Pressure

The 10" vacuum hose is attached to both the supply and return sides of the system. During cleaning, all dirt and debris is pulled to the vacuum.



### Step 6. Hand Cleaning

The metal box under the floor register is called a "stack-boot." We spray a degreasing agent and hand clean each one with a cotton towel.



### Step 7. Maximizing Vacuum

All registers are covered with a magnetic-vinyl sheet. As each run is cleaned the cover is removed, maximizing the air flow in that duct line.



### Step 8. Scrub the System

Pulling large volumes of air toward the vacuum, we now send our scrubbing tools down each supply run. Specially designed plastic plugs insure there's no air flow loss.



### Step 9. Cold Air Returns

Once all supply registers are clean, we move to the return air system. This includes all the grill covers and cold-air drops throughout the house.



### Step 10. Furnace Interior

If needed, the furnace is cleaned with the air-washing and vacuum of the drop, filter box, blower fan, cabinet interior and combustion chamber.



### Step 11. Antimicrobial Sanitizer

If desired, the duct cleaning is completed by flushing the ducts with an environmentally safe antimicrobial sanitizer to inhibit the growth of bacteria and mold.



### Step 12. Wrapping it Up!

New galvanized access panels are installed over the openings created for the vacuum hose. All debris is removed.
